Cross-Border Collaboration

The University of Applied Sciences and Arts Northwestern Switzerland (FHNW), with its nine schools, is a regionally rooted institution with both national and international reach. Its bachelor's and master's programs, as well as continuing education offerings, are designed to be practical and aligned with market needs. Depending on the program, students can choose from full-time, part-time, work-study, practice-integrated, or blended options. FHNW campuses are located in Aarau, Basel, Brugg/Windisch, Liestal, Muttenz, Olten, Solothurn, and Zofingen.

FHNW was established on the basis of the 2004 inter-cantonal agreement between Aargau, Basel-Landschaft, Basel-Stadt, and Solothurn. It emerged from the merger of the universities of applied sciences in Aargau, both Basels, and Solothurn, the Solothurn University of Teacher Education, the University of Education and Social Work of both Basels, and the music colleges of the Basel Music Academy. FHNW brings together all existing university-level programs in Northwestern Switzerland, spanning engineering, construction, business, design and art, social work, education, applied psychology, life sciences, and music. Today, FHNW employs about 2,000 staff and educates over 7,000 students.

Document management seamlessly integrated into SAP

The Finance Department, responsible for centralized data entry, is located in Brugg. However, FHNW employees work in nearly 100 different buildings throughout Northwestern Switzerland. They're all connected and use a central SAP system. Among other things, this setup helps them efficiently process 35,000 accounts payable invoices every year. Invoices are received at various locations, coded and approved onsite, then mailed to Brugg for final booking and digital archiving. This is where Therefore steps in.

Peter Fuchs, Head of Business Applications, explains: "We were looking for a document management system that would make it easier to handle invoices and other records from accounting and HR. Most importantly, we wanted to simplify document access, so we could respond to requests faster."

Saving time, boosting quality

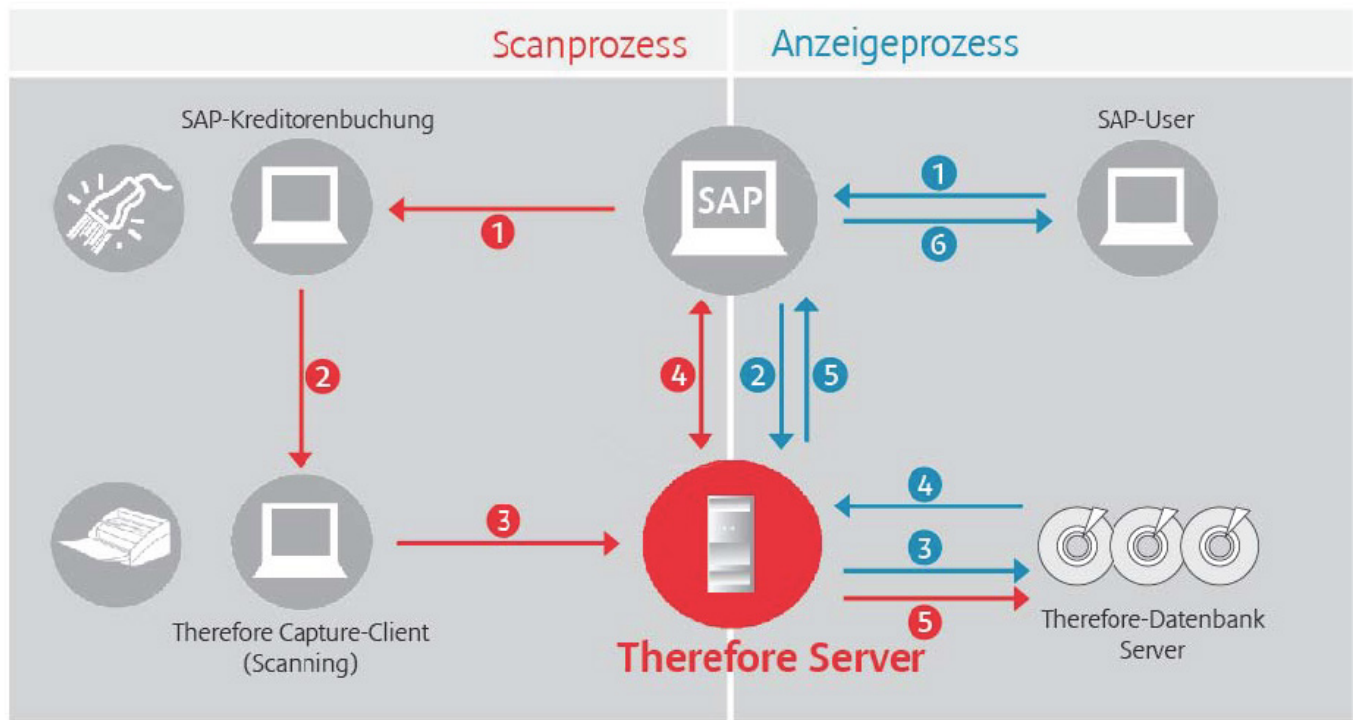
Since SAP doesn't store actual documents, before introducing Therefore, staff had to go to the archives to locate the needed records whenever a request came in. Now, with Therefore, about 300 employees can instantly access invoices, personnel files, and other documents online from their own desks—always in line with strictly defined access rights.



This approach saves both time and labor costs. Plus, it boosts work quality for our staff, giving them more time to focus on the tasks that really matter.

Therefore has been up and running since August 2007. During the evaluation phase, several solutions were carefully reviewed. Scanning Process

1. Capture the vendor invoice in SAP using a barcode
2. Scan invoices with the Therefore Capture Client
3. Import scanned documents into Therefore
4. Exchange metadata between Therefore and SAP
5. Store documents with metadata in Therefore

Display Process

1. Open a vendor invoice entry
2. Retrieve the document from SAP and send it to the Therefore server
3. Therefore accesses the document from the database
4. Transfer the file to the Therefore server
5. Therefore hands the document back to the SAP system
6. Display the document to the user
