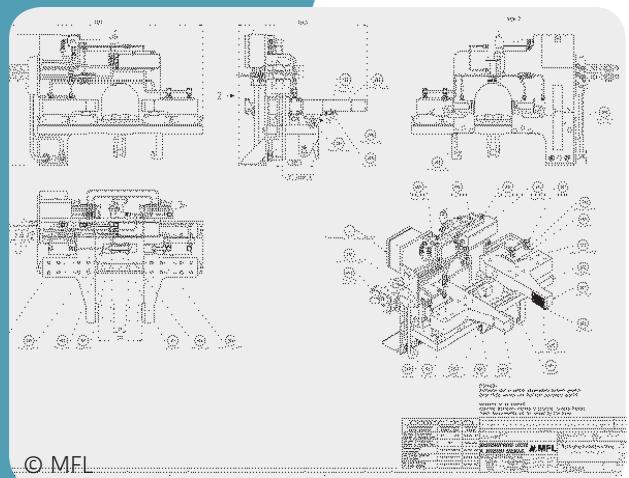

CAD drawings, as well as financial and HR documents, are securely stored for safekeeping.

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Key Figures and Facts

- 2,000 new documents are stored in the system every day
- 6,000 documents are searched for daily
- 3,500 incoming invoices are processed each month using barcodes
- 2,200 outgoing invoices are archived per month



In early 2003, Therefore™ was introduced for the first time to digitize the archive and ensure that documents were available where needed, in the right quality.

Before Therefore™, finding archived documents was a slow and tedious task. If a department needed a document, they had to submit a request.

Then someone would head to the archive, locate the specific document, make a copy, and send it to the department through interoffice mail. Digitizing documents and microfilm was especially important

because drawings and engineering plans (like CAD files) are at the heart of MFL's data.

As of 2014, Therefore™ contains around 300,000 drawings and plans, all of which can be accessed in just seconds thanks to the system's user-friendly design. Over the years, the platform has expanded and is now used in nearly every area of business at MFL—from purchasing and production to delivery. Shared service teams like HR and Finance also benefit from the extensive features of Therefore™.

Building on the positive results from the first phase of the project, MFL decided in 2006 to integrate incoming and outgoing invoices, including an approval workflow, into Therefore™ to further reduce administrative workload. On average, around 3,500 incoming invoices are captured via barcode and approximately 2,200 outgoing invoices are archived each month. Thanks to a custom verification logic and SAP integration, all invoices are checked for accuracy. Audit compliance is ensured since outgoing invoices are archived and linked to their corresponding orders.

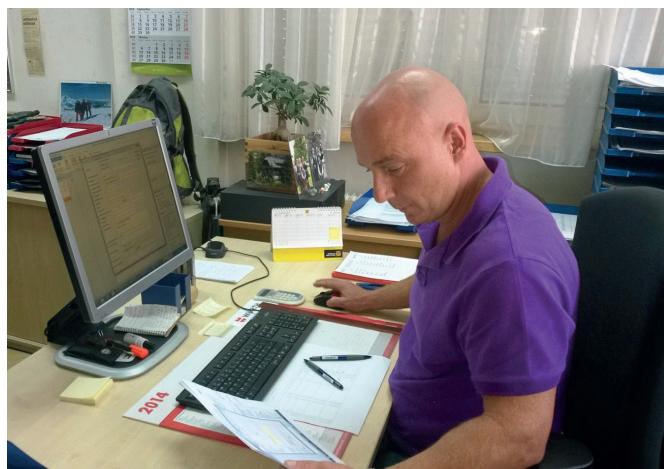
These successful developments led to another expansion of the Therefore™ system in 2008: the Exchange Connector was added to automatically archive emails. After that, various smaller workflows were implemented to archive different types of documents, such as employee information and documents related to orders and production. Today, the system stores over 2,000 new documents daily and handles about 6,000 searches—spanning various departments, branches, and even across borders.
